| 1. | In the event of child abduction, staff and group coordinator will determine if a terror or weapon threat is involved. |
| 2. | No one should leave the premises until authorized by emergency personnel. |
| 3. | Staff will call 911. |
| 4. | Staff will sound alarm to alert child abduction lockdown—AMBER ALERT |
| 5. | Staff will monitor parking lot and note description and direction of any vehicle leaving. |
| 6. | Notify all staff and visitors of child's description. |
| 7. | Staff will direct visitors to safe area: |
| 8. | Visitors should remain in groups and noise level kept to a minimum. |
| 9. | Confirm head count. |
| 10 | O.Staff will search all areas. |
| 13 | L.Staff and visitor coordinators will determine appropriateness of leaving premises or staying in the safe area with the guidance of emergency personnel. |
